FEAD and its members stand for industrial excellence in all waste management operations. The sector is set to invest 60 BN € over the next 12 years on innovation and capacity building.



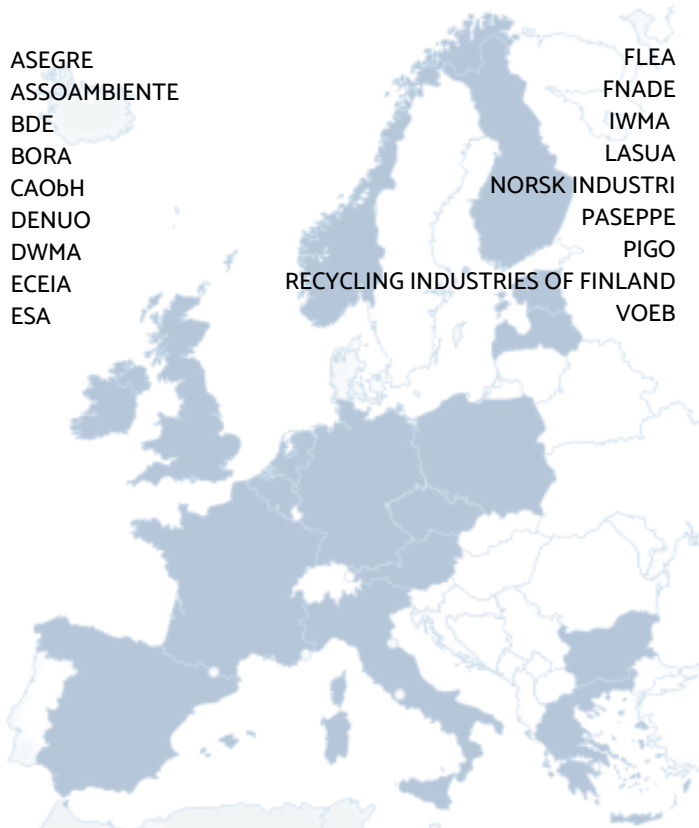
We need a fair and transparent market for waste to create a level playing field for the primary industry and recycling industry.

THE STATE OF THINGS

» Despite its stated ambitions, the EU is currently not on track to meet its targets. «

12%

In 2021, the EU's Circular Material Use Rate (CMUR) was at 11.7%.

The rate has maintained a stable growth trend from 2004 to 2019, before declining in the years affected by the COVID-19 pandemic.

40%

In 2020, the recycling of all waste was approximated at 40% at EU-level.

This was largely equivalent to the waste being sent to landfills and other disposals operations.

FEAD'S GOALS

With increased future demand for materials, annual waste generation projected to increase, and the EU faced with increasing raw material scarcity, it is crucial to boost the EU's domestic capacity to supply its industry with high quality raw materials from recycling.

25%

The EU should reach 25% of Circular Material Use rate.

We need to accelerate the uptake of secondary raw material and support the EU's ambition to double its CMUR.

75%

At FEAD, we pledge to achieve a 75% target for the recycling of all waste in the EU by 2035.

Concerted and ambitious action is required to boost the uptake of secondary raw materials into the economy.
